Chevy Chase At Home (CC@H), an aging-in-place village, is a non-profit organization offering a broad range of volunteer-provided services to enable older adults to remain in their own homes. To enhance connection and engagement across generations, we also provide a variety of social and educational programs. Residents of ten Chevy Chase neighborhoods are eligible to join. 1

Family Membership entitles all adult household members (60 years +) to use **volunteer-provided services**, to participate in social, exercise and educational programs, and to access neighbor-recommended service provider lists. **The cost is** <u>\$600 per household.</u>

Individual Membership entitles adults (60 years +) who reside alone to use **volunteer-provided services**, to participate in social, exercise and educational programs, and to access neighbor-recommended service provider lists. **The cost is** <u>\$450.</u>

Membership runs from now until March 31, 2022.

- **Transportation** to medical appointments, shopping, and more.
- **Household Assistance,** such as putting out recycling bins, fixing a leaky faucet, changing hearing aid batteries and light bulbs, replacing smoke and carbon monoxide detectors and installing grab bars.
- **Technical Help** and advice with your smart phone, tablet or computer.
- Friendly Visits including respite visits to provide conversation and relief breaks for caregivers.
- Medical Notetaking during medical appointments by trained volunteers.
- **Safety Programs** offered for no charge, such as Home Safety Visits provided by Montgomery County Fire and Rescue Service.
- Neighbor Network—A volunteer checks in every 3-4 weeks and in times of inclement weather.

Family & Individual Members receive these benefits:

- **Cultural Programs and Social Events.** Enjoy in-person and Zoom events to discuss ideas, make friends, learn new skills, see movies, attend museums, and more.
- Educational Presentations by experts and notable authors on subjects that interest you, such as national elections, movies, art history, health, safety, fall prevention and travel.
- Join Member-Led Interest Groups for movie and book discussion, coffee & conversation, knitting, brunch bunch, walking club, and more.
- **Participate in Senior Exercise Classes.** Class offerings currently include Cardio and Strength training, Zumba® Gold, and Music and Movement.
- Receive the CC@H Newsletter (via mail), event bulletins and updates (via email).
